Former USPHS Medical Epidemiologist Leads Pop Epi

Dr. Thomas Weiser

Dr. Weiser served in the US Public Health Service for 25 years. For 16 of those years, he was a Medical Epidemiologist for the Portland Area Indian Health Service assigned to the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board and Northwest Tribal Epidemiology Center. His work focused on improving public health surveillance for Northwest Tribes. Dr. Weiser addressed important public health issues such as declining immunization coverage, substance use disorder and overdose, COVID-19, syphilis and hepatitis C. He also served as the Co-Chair of the Portland Area IHS Institutional Review Board providing oversight of human subjects' protection and guidance to researchers and tribes. He now resides in Oregon and occasionally Japan.
