NPAIHB Legislative & Policy Update May 28, 2024



FY 2024 IHS - Interior Appropriations

- On March 8, 2024, Congress passed a six-bill FY 2024 Minibus, included IHS Funding
 - Essentially flat funded with only a .05% increase above FY 2023 enacted level
 - Largest increases are for:
 - ➤ Contract Support Costs at \$1.1 billion; and 105(I) Leases at \$149 million
 - Small increases in Hospitals & Health Clinics (1.9%), Dental Services (1.8%) and Mental Health (2.04%) subaccounts
 - Decrease IHS Facilities subaccounts of 15.17%; Sanitation Facilities Construction (SFC)
 \$72.5 million most impacted
 - Zero increase to Purchased and Referred Care (PRC); loss to NW Tribes
- FY 2025 Advance Appropriations \$5.19 billion
 - Does not include System, the Indian Health Care Improvement Fund, Contract Support Costs, Payments for 105(I) Tribal Leases, Sanitation Facilities Construction, and Health Care Facilities Construction



FY 2024 IHS - HHS Budget Recissions

- FY 2024 Minibus IHS Funding Recissions in Division E
 - Section 447 of Division E rescinds \$350 million from section 11001 of the American Rescue Plan Act (P.L. 117-2).
 - Section 448 rescinds \$90 million from IHS annual appropriations in FY 2023 and prior years unless those funds were designated emergencies by Congress under the authority of a concurrent resolution on the budget or under the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.
- FY 2024 Further Consolidated Appropriations Act (included HHS, Education, and Related)
 - Rescinds \$1.25 billion in HHS funding from the Nonrecurring Expenses Fund (NEF)
 - Portland Area IHS Regional Specialty Referral Center was allocated \$165 million in NEF Funds to build the first center
 - These funds are in jeopardy of being rescinded if not obligated by September 30, 2024



FY 2025 President's Indian Health Service Budget

- Released on March 11, 2024
 - Overall, \$8.2 billion in discretionary and mandatory funding
 - +\$1.1 billion (16%) over FY 2023 enacted budget
 - Includes \$260 million in mandatory funding for Special Diabetes
 Program for Indians Proposed to make IHS funding mandatory in FY 2026

FY 2025 Interior and Labor, HHS, Education (LHE) Appropriations Subcommittee (S/C) Testimony

Interior – IHS Funding

- House Testimony Deadline was 5/1/24;
 NPAIHB submitted testimony
- NPAIHB Chairman Nickolaus Lewis testified before House S/C on 5/8/24
- Full House Appropriations Committee markup on 5/23/24
- Senate Testimony Deadline was 5/15/24;
 NPAIHB submitted testimony

LHE - HHS Funding

- House Testimony deadline was 5/3/24;
 NPAIHB submitted testimony
- House LHE appropriations will be cut by 10-11% based on the House Majority's priorities.
- Full House Appropriations Committee markup on 5/23/24
- Senate Testimony is due 5/24/24; NPAIHB submitted testimony

NPAIHB Testimony for both House and Senate was focused on the Northwest & National Opioid Summit Priorities and NPAIHB Policy Priorities



Looking Forward: FY 2026 IHS & HHS Budgets

- On Nov. 28, 2024, FY 2026 Portland Area Tribes made recommendations on the FY 2026 IHS Budget
- On Feb. 13-14, 2024, all IHS National Tribal Budget Formulation Workgroup members convened to roll-up IHS budget in Washington, D.C. on Feb 13-14, 2024
- On April 9-10, 2024, HHS Annual Tribal Budget Consultation was held in Washington D.C.
 - Co-Chairs of the IHS National Tribal Budget Formulation Workgroup testified on April 9, 2024, at the HHS Annual Tribal Budget Consultation in Washington, D.C.
 - NPAIHB Chair, and Portland Area Representatives, attended; NPAIHB submitted testimony on FY 2026 IHS and HHS Budgets



Admin Updates: CMS

- CMS Releases Updated Guidance on Medicare Provider Enrollment for Marriage and Family Therapists (MFTs) and Mental Health Counselors (MHCs)
- CMS Working on a regulatory fix to the Four Walls issue; grace period ends on Feb 11, 2025
 - Next Step: CMS Notice of Proposed Rule Making; CMS attempting to complete before end of 2024.
- CMS's Approval of 1115 Traditional Healing Waivers; Tribal comments on CMS's proposed guidance were due on May 6, 2024; NPAIHB submitted comments
 - CMS to create guidance; after 4 walls NPRM completed; Tribal advocates pushing for this to happen before end of 2024



Admin Update: SAMHSA & DEA HHS

- <u>SAMHSA Final Rule Released on 1/31/24: Medications for the Treatment of Opioid Use Disorder,</u> 42 CFR Part 8.
 - The Final Rule went into effect on April 2, 2024; compliance is required by October 2, 2024; increases access to care and treatment for opioid use disorder.
 - Allows time for Opioid Treatment Programs (OTPs) to prepare for the changes; and states to review their regulations that impact how this rule is implemented.

- HHS & DEA Issues Second Temporary Extension of COVID-19 Telemedicine Flexibilities for Prescription Controlled Substances; ends Dec. 31st, 2024

Admin Updates: IHS Dear Tribal Leader Letters

- IHS May 20 Letter: The IHS Director shared the FY 2024 funding allocations for the annual Sanitation Facilities Construction program appropriation.
- IHS May 21 Letter: The IHS Director initiated a Tribal Consultation and Urban Confer to see your guidance and recommendations on funding methodologies for seven (7) IHS behavorial health initiatives, focusing on current distributed grants.
- IHS May 21 Letter: The IHS Director, along with the Co-Chair of the Community Health Aide Program Tribal Advisory Group, Brook Bender, invites your continued participation in our collaborative efforts to support and expand the Community Health Aide Program in Indian Country.


