

2018 GPRA Dental Measures

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What's New in 2018...

- Integrated Data Collection System (IDCS)
 - This year 2018 the GPRA data will be pulled from the data received by the National Data Warehouse (NDW).

What's has changed

- Tribes that don't use RPMS can be included in GPRA reporting**
 - Since Tribes that don't use RPMS still report their data to the NDW, now they can be included in the Portland Area aggregated reporting.
- Fiscal Year vs. GPRA Year**
 - The report period has changed from July - June to October - September.
 - Dental visits, sealants and topical fluoride provided during July - September 2017 will not count toward the 2018 Dental Measures
- Tribes can Opt-out of Reporting**
 - Currently I have put in the request for Tribes that do not use the full RPMS/EHR to be Opted out.
 - Burns CLUSIT Sauk-Suiattle
 - Hoh Kootenai Stillaguamish
 - Samish Suquamish Upper Skagit

2018 Dental Measures

Access to Dental Services

During Fiscal Year 2018, achieve the target rate of 27.2% for the proportion of patients who receive dental services.

2017 target - 29.7%
Target decreased by 2.5%

2018 Dental Measures

Access to Dental Services

Logic: Patients with a documented dental visit *during the Fiscal Year*

Dental exams are searched for in the following way:

- Dental Codes: 0000, 0190 or 0191
- CPT Codes: D0190 or D0191
- ICD-10 Codes: Z01.20 or Z01.21
- Exam Code: 30 (Dental)
- POV/ICD-9 V72.2
- Any PRC visit with an ADA code

2018 Dental Measures

Dental Sealants

During FY 2018, achieve the target rate of 16.0% for the proportion of patients ages 2 through 15 with at least one or more intact dental sealants.

*2017 target - 16.6%
Target decreased by 0.6%*

2018 Dental Measures

Dental Sealants

Age of patient is calculated at the beginning of the Report Period.

Dental Sealants are searched for in the following way:

During the Fiscal Year

- Dental Codes: 1351, 1352 or 1353
- CPT Codes: D1351, D1352 or D1353

During the past 3 years from the end of the Report Period

- Dental Code: 0007 (Sealant Present - No additional sealants indicated)

Any PRC visit with the above ADA codes

During FY 2018, achieve the target rate of **30.0%** for the proportion of patients age 1 through 15 who received at least one topical fluoride application.

2017 target - 29.9%
Target increased by 0.1%

2018 Dental Measures

Topical Fluoride

Fluoride applications are searched for in the following way:

- ADA Codes: 1201, 1203, 1204, 1205 (old codes), 1206, 1208 or 5986
- CPT Codes: D1201, D1203, D1204, D1205 (old codes) D1206, D1208, D5986 or 99188
- POV/ICD-9: V07.31
- ICD-10: Z29.3
- Any PRC visit with the above codes

Performance Improvement Tips

- If your facility's dental visits are paid for with PRC funds, ensure the final payment for each purchase order is posted (paid)
- ADA Codes are entered for each document.
- The PRC/CHS to PCC link is set to "on" position.
- If using Dentrix/RPMS, and not entering ICD-10 codes, the ZZZ.999 codes must be completed in RPMS, or they will not pass to PCC and get exported.

Points to Ponder

How to guide

Dentrix

- You can directly complete procedures that have default ICD-10 codes.
- You must enter treatment plan procedures that do not have default codes and then add the ICD-10 code prior to completing the procedure.
- Communicate with your coder regarding this process change, they may have some more tips to make your life easier.
- If you select no ICD-10 code, ZZZ.999 is the default.
- ****Please remember that you cannot modify a Completed procedure, you must delete the procedure and add a new procedure.****
